



The Laurens High School coaching staff would like to welcome Coach Brandon Sarver to our team. He will serve as the new Defensive Coordinator on Coach Smith's staff. Coach Sarver has spent the past six years coaching in the defensive secondary at Dorman High School. During his time at Dorman, the Cavaliers appeared in three state championship games. His players experienced great success, with three players earning selections to postseason all-star games, and six players continuing their playing career at the collegiate level.

Coach Sarver is familiar with Laurens County, having served as an assistant coach at Presbyterian College under Head Coaches Bobby Bentley and Harold Nichols from 2008-2013. He began his coaching career at Wake Forest University in 2003 where he served as both an offensive and defensive assistant during his five years under 2006 National Coach of the Year recipient Jim Grobe. While at WFU, the Demon Deacons won the 2006 ACC Championship, played in 2 bowl games, and represented the ACC in the 2007 Orange Bowl.

A native of Bluefield, WV, Coach Sarver graduated from the University of Georgia in 2003, earning dual degrees in Business and Education. He lettered as a safety on the UGA football team for Head Coaches Jim Donnan and Mark Richt. The bulldogs played in bowl games every season during his time at UGA. Coach Sarver has been married to his wife Aimee of Atlanta, GA since 2009, and they have two young sons Will (8), and Reid (5).
